Things to consider before your hunt

BEFORE YOUR HUNT (Go over this with your outfitter)

Gross Cost Of Hunt

Gross For Observer

Deposit Paid (*Before Good Will Plan Fee*)

Less Good Will Plan Fee

Total Deposit Applied To Hunt

Balance Due On/Before Arrival

*Often due 30-60 days in advance: ask your outfitter.
No personal checks are accepted, in most cases.*

License Fees, Game Quotas, Trophy Fees,
Bonus Fees

(Explain: Know when/where to obtain before you go.)

Charters or Taxis

*(Do not get on a charter flight unless you know the total
cost; any changes, private charter, or extra baggage,
freight or service may cost much more.)*

Commercial Airfare

Taxes

Crating, Shipping, Import-Export Permits

Taxidermy, Meat, Horns, Skins, Permits,
Transportation Costs

Camp Staff Tips

(A great incentive!)

Hotels, Meals, Drinks, Snacks, Curios

Miscellaneous Expenses

(Any change in plans can cost more.)

Things to consider after your hunt

AFTER YOUR HUNT

Before you leave camp, resolve (on paper) any payments, refunds, problems, promises, or trophy shipments. The outfitter wants to please you and invites your comments before you leave camp.
